

**WAIVER OF LIABILITY
AND
RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS**



As a condition of participating in The Canadian Death Race, the Bib Holder (or the Bib Holder's guardian/parent in the case of a minor), assumes all risk of personal injury, death or property loss resulting from any cause whatsoever, including but not limited to: extreme and unknown risks in extremely difficult and hazardous terrain for even well trained athletes under the most favorable conditions. The Bib Holder acknowledges that he or she is physically fit and sufficiently trained to participate in this extreme mountainous endurance event, in which altitude, and broad temperature ranges will be a factor, and assumes all risks of such participation. The Bib Holder is advised of exposure to physical injury from a number of factors, including but not limited to snow on the trail, lack of or abundance of water, animals, vehicular traffic, etc. The Bib Holder also acknowledges that a portion of the race may take place at night and assume the risks for participating in the darkness, which augments the dangers described above. The Bib Holder acknowledges that the race takes place over remote territory and assumes the risk of injury or incapacitated in a location where it is difficult or impossible for event management to deliver required medical aid in time to avoid physical injury or even death. Knowing these facts, the Bib Holder nevertheless, in consideration for participating, hereby for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, waive, release and discharge the Canadian Institute of Extreme Racing, The Canadian Death Race, Town of Grande Cache, Alberta Athletics Association, any official sponsor entity, and the officers, directors, shareholders and/or members, agents, and employees of each, all medical and other personnel assisting with the race, volunteers, or any other person connected with this event, from any and all rights, claims of or in connection with my participation in this event. The Bib Holder further agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Canadian Institute of Extreme Racing or any official sponsors, and the directors, officers, members and agents of each, against all claims, demands and causes of action. In addition, The Bib Holder agrees to be responsible for the actions of their crew. This release extends to all claims of every kind and nature whatsoever, including injury or death, property damage or loss, whether cause known or unknown or due to negligence on the part of the Race. Should any legal proceedings arise, I also hereby agree for such to be subject to the laws of Alberta Canada and dealt with within the jurisdiction of Alberta and no other jurisdiction. The Bib Holder grants my irrevocable permission to the Canadian Institute of Extreme Racing and its authorized agents, to use my name and any photographs, videotapes, motion pictures, recordings, and any other record of my participation in this event. No entry will be accepted without accepting this disclaimer. Race management reserves the right to refuse any entry. No entry will be accepted without full payment.
